Who is gifted?

Arizona children must score in the 97th percentile or above on a state-approved test that measures reasoning ability. Some districts have more lenient eligibility thresholds.

The tests generally measure three areas of giftedness: verbal, math and non-verbal, with non-verbal being spatial abilities, the skills needed by air-traffic controllers and architects. Children can be gifted in more than one area.
