Voters could overturn developments

A date has been set for a ballot measure to overturn the approval of two developments in Santa Cruz County, Las Mesas and Sopori Ranch.

The measure will go before voters during the general election on Nov. 4, said county elections director Melinda Meek.

The developments previously won approvals from Santa Cruz County supervisors, but a coalition of area residents opposed to the plan succeeded in having the issue placed on the ballot.

The group, called the Coalition for Responsible Growth, believes the developments are too dense and do not provide enough open space.
