Focus Group Instructions

Choose two of the topics below. You will move from your first choice group to your second group choice after 45 minutes.

The Groups' Topics

1. Can raising voters' political conscience give citizens the political tools they need to change community problems like corruption?
2. Laws that require education of youth should be strictly enforced to reduce poverty.
3. Light pollution from ambos Nogales diminishes viewing capabilities of the world-class telescopes in Southern Arizona.
4. Repairs in the water infrastructure in Nogales, Sonora, can improve water quality and delivery in ambos Nogales.
5. Border militia groups are vigilantes and should be stopped.

Instructions for each group

1. Introduce yourselves, presenters and participants – 5 minutes
2. Describe the problem and the sources used – 5 minutes
3. Describe the Alternatives the group researched – 5 minutes
4. Describe the proposed policy of the group and the sources used - 5 minutes
5. Describe the Action plan and the sources used – minutes – 5 minutes
6. Write down the problem for the group to see and read it
7. Whole group discuss the problem - 10 minutes
8. Group discusses the proposed policy. Group offers suggestions for action of the policy - 10 minutes
9. Change groups – 5 minutes
10. Start over with the new group
